The Program: Researching the United States Citizenship and Information Service (USCIS) Records



This presentation will be an overview of three historical eras of US immigration and naturalization records, illustrated with documents of Jewish immigrants. Using a timeline tool she demonstrates how plotting an immigrant's life events can identify what records may exist for that particular immigrant and where these records can be found.

Speaker: Marian Smith retired in 2018 after thirty years as an Historian for the Immigration and Naturalization Service (INS), later US Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS). She now speaks to groups on US immigration and nationality records and leads the I&N Records Fortnightly study group. Marian last spoke with JGSCV in 2013.
