The Three Great Myths of Jewish Genealogy explores the commonly believed stories that prevent people from finding out more of their family history. With good humor, Chuck Weinstein will provide ideas that will help you uncover the truth about your family history before they emigrated to the US and will help you understand how to research the records that are available to you in Europe.

Speaker: Chuck Weinstein. Weinstein has been involved in family research for over 30 years. He has traced his own family back to the 15th century in one branch. An early volunteer for JewishGen, Chuck was chosen the first Susan E. King Volunteer of the Year in 2019. He is a Past President of the Jewish Genealogy Society of Long Island, Vice President of the Genealogy Federation of Long Island, and the Towns Director of the JewishGen Ukraine Research Division. Chuck grew up in the San Fernando Valley, but currently lives in Bellport, NY.
