## How a Record Match Almost Led Me to an Insane Asylum



A Record Match on MyHeritage led Daniel to a file that threw everything he thought he knew about his great-grandmother into question. His quest to find the truth led him to a wealth of newly available records from the Holocaust in the Arolsen Archives — which just might help you find more information about the fate of your own family before, during, and after the war. Learn the techniques, tips, and tricks Daniel used to sift the true from the false and find out where to look and what to ask when researching a Jewish family that lived during the Holocaust.

**Speaker:** Daniel Horowitz. Daniel has been dedicated to genealogy since 1986. He is involved in several crowdsource digitization and transcription projects (<https://csindexing.com/igra.php>) and holds a board-level position at The Israel Genealogy Research Association (IGRA). Since 2006 Daniel has been working at MyHeritage (<https://www.myheritage.com/>) liaising with genealogy societies, bloggers, and media, as well as lecturing, and attending conferences around the world.
