#### The Program:

The presentation will focus on new aspects of USHMM’s collections search. Megan will review the new interface and features. She will also introduce the genealogy information that can be found in their catalog metadata, such as biographies attached to archival collections, and other online resources people may not know about, like the memoir collection.

#### The Speaker

*Megan Lewis has worked at the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum since 1998. Since October 2010, she has worked as a reference librarian at the Museum’s Library and Archives reference desk. Previously, she worked for the division of the Museum that specialized in researching the fates of specific individuals. In that work, she used a wide variety of collections in the Museum’s holdings. Megan has given presentations about the Museum and its resources at genealogical conferences, gatherings of Holocaust survivors and the American Library Association. She received her BA in History from the University of Oregon in 1997 and her Master’s of Library Science from the University of Maryland, College Park in 2006.*
