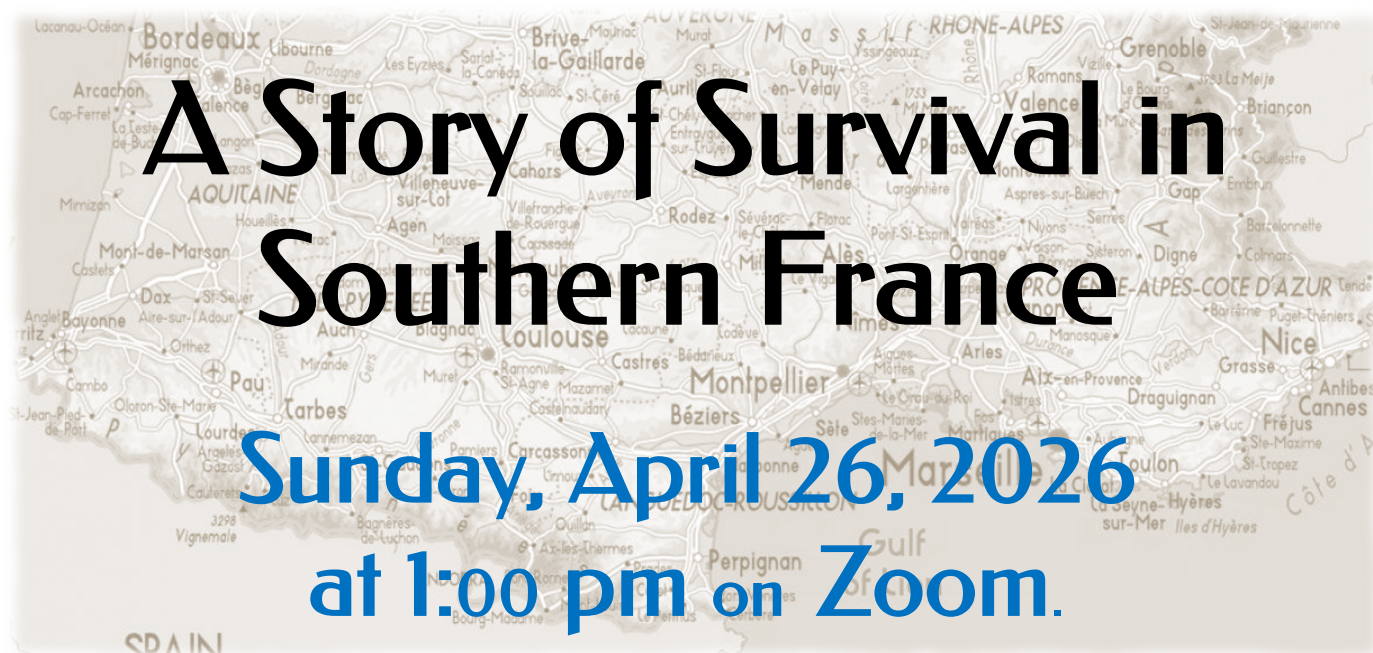


We welcome back

Karen Franklin

Director of Family Research at the Leo Baeck Institute & Director of Outreach for
JewishGen at the Museum of Jewish Heritage



Among her numerous projects, Karen Franklin has spent over a decade tracing the histories of more than 100 refugees assisted by the Lehman family before, during and after the Holocaust. **One person survived in hiding in Southern France during the War**, but the details of her experience were not determined -- that is, until descendants donated her papers to the Leo Baeck Institute. In this lecture, Karen describes how she tracked down descendants of the rescuers, the shocking stories she uncovered, and the resources she used in the search. The research is ongoing.
